1. Exhibitors and those visiting the Society's Show must comply with the regulations and conditions imposed by The North of England Horticultural Society.
2. Liability for Loss or Damage. The organisers cannot accept any responsibility for the safety of exhibits or other property. All reasonable precautions against theft or damage will be taken, but all exhibits will be staged at their owner's risk.
3. The staging and judging of all Gladioli exhibited will be based on the NAGS System of Classification and Judging, as modified by the BGS, any seedling must be hybridized, raised, grown and shown by the exhibitor, unless stated.
4. Exhibits must be shown without supports or pins, or stuck by artificial means above the top of the containers.
5. The Council of the BGS reserves the right to decide all points not specifically provided for in these Show Regulations and the Show Secretary has authority to act on its behalf in matters of urgency.
6. All exhibits should be named (if seedlings, numbered and classified). Failure to do so will not disqualify, but may lead to loss of points when competition is close.
7. All exhibits must be the property of the individual in whose name they are exhibited in the Show and must be removed from the Show between 4.00pm and 5.30pm on Sunday 16th September 2018.
8. Exhibits must not be removed before 4.00pm on Sunday 16th September 2018 without the express permission of the Show Committee.
9. The number of entries in any class is unlimited, except Class 3 which is restricted to one entry per exhibitor.
10. Exhibits may be staged from 7pm on Thursday 13th September 2018 until 7am on Friday 14th September 2018.
11. The Marquee will be cleared at 7.30am on Friday 14th September 2018 and only persons authorised by the Show Committee will be permitted to be present during the judging of the exhibits.
